There will be caroling provided by the Girl Scouts, hot cocoa, treats and a visit from Santa assisted by the Albertson Fire Company. The S.T.O.P. Program (Stop Throwing Out Pollutants) will be offered to us on Saturday, November 20th, 2022 between 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. This event will take place at North Hempstead Beach Park, North Lot, 175 West Shore Road, Port Washington. This program no longer accepts pharmaceuticals; please drop those at Nassau County Police Department. Residents can bring documents for shredding. Big Brothers Big Sisters will be there to accept gently used clothing, household items, bikes, luggage and toys.

FRIENDLY REMINDERS

Please don't put your garbage out too early. Place your trash receptacles either in an accessible place alongside your house or at curbside the **night before your scheduled pick-up day**. The Town's Department of Solid Waste Management offers residents the opportunity to properly dispose of residential recyclables and non-hazardous household waste on Sundays. The Sunday Resident Drop-off hours of operation are Sundays (except Holidays) from 7:30AM to 2:30PM at 999 West Shore Road, Roslyn. The minimum charge is \$5/vehicle, which includes 100 pound disposal. Every additional 20 pounds is \$1.00/20lb. Recyclables are No Charge.

Please continue to recycle! Recyclable bin/container must be placed at the curb the night before your scheduled pickup. The Town no longer provides residents with a Town-designated receptacle for setting out recyclables. Instead, they are providing colored decals to use on your own receptacles. To receive a free set of recycling decals in the mail to label your recycling bin, please contact the Town. WARNING! Nassau County Police are urging residents to lock car doors at night due to a rash of incidents. These robberies have happened during nighttime hours and the early morning. There are several tips from the Nassau County Police to help prevent car theft including closing all windows, locking all doors, not leaving your car running unattended and taking the transponder with you when you leave your vehicle if you have a "keyless" car.
